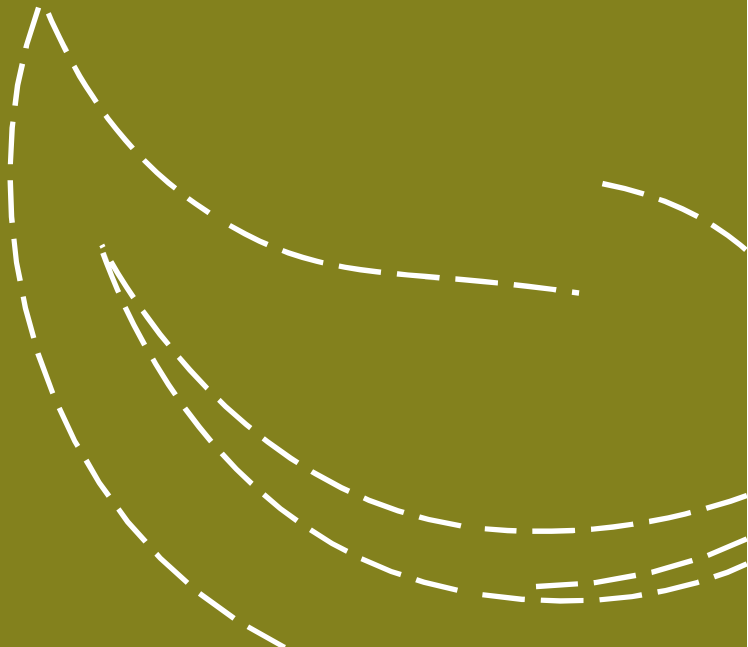

# College Profile

The Northern Cape CET College was established on 1 April 2015 under the auspices of the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) in terms of the Continuing Education and Training Act, Act No. 16 of 2006 (as amended). Our purpose is to address the education needs of youth and adults in Northern Cape communities who, for various reasons, have not completed their schooling or who have never attended school. We seek to facilitate a cycle of lifelong learning in communities by promoting the development of skills through both academic and skills programmes. These include literacy, numeracy and vocational skills to enhance personal, social, family and employment experiences

We aim to accomplish these goals by:

- Addressing the injustice of the past;
- Bringing quality education closer to communities;
- Allowing communities to be involved in identifying their needs;
- Offering affordable and relevant programmes to the communities we serve;
- Pursuing excellence and promoting the full realisation of the potential of every student; and
- Responding to the labour needs of the country, labour market and the communities.

The College's Central Office is located at 19 Oliver Road, additionally, the College has 7 Community Learning Centers (CLCs) spread across seven municipalities and five district municipalities in Northern Cape, namely:

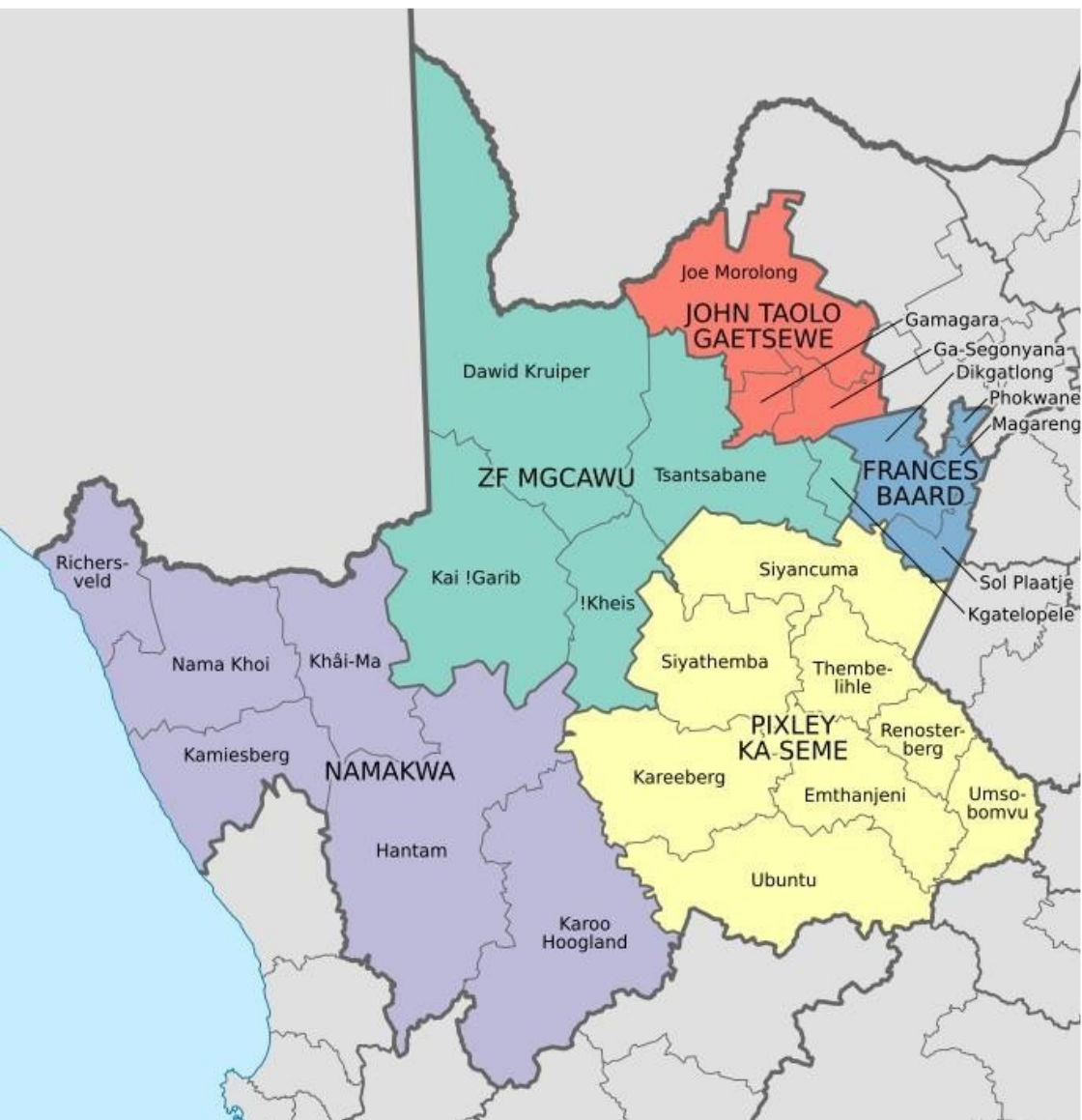
1. Sol Plaatje Municipality: 1 Community Learning Center ;

# General Information

## Post-Literacy Programmes

The Northern Cape CET College's Post-Literacy Programmes are ideal for students who want to continue with their education. These include Basic Adult Education courses for sub-levels 1–3:

- Level 1: Offers numeracy and languages (mother tongue and English, depending on the needs of students);
- Level 2: Offers numeracy and languages and an option of integrated studies or a skills programme; and
- Level 3: Offers numeracy and languages, integrated studies or a skills programme.

## Academic Qualifications

The following academic qualifications are offered:

- General Education and Training Certificate (GETC);
- National Senior Certificate; and
- National Senior Certificate rewrites.

### GETC-ABET Level 4 Qualification

The GETC-ABET qualification (NQF Level 1), with ID No. 71751, provides adult learners with fundamental basics in general education. The purpose of this qualification is to equip learners with foundational learning by acquiring knowledge, skills and values in specified learning areas. It also allows learners to choose elective unit standards, which relate to occupational learning relevant to their area of interest or specialisation. The qualification comprises:

- Fundamentals;
- Core; and
- Elective component.

To acquire a GETC-ABET qualification, students need to obtain a minimum of 120 credits at ABET Level 4. An achievement of 120 credits should be obtained from learning areas in the Fundamentals, Core and Elective categories according to the rules of combination below.

*Rules of Combination for the GETC-ABET Qualification:*

- One Official Language: 23 Credits
- Mathematical Literacy: 16 Credits OR
